



Million Paws Walk 2025 – Role Descriptions

Competition Assistants

You'll be managing the competitions arena and will need good time management and organisational skills, be able to handle pressure, and be comfortable and confident working with different types of dogs.

Doggy Drinks Attendants

You'll be helping at the doggy drinks bar, selling drinks and puppicinos! Volunteers will need to be outgoing and happy to have a chat to pull people in to make a purchase! The role includes selling, preparing and serving menu items and taking payment via cash and EFTPOS machines.

Entry Attendants

You'll be the first person our attendees will be seeing on the day so you need to be friendly, approachable and able to remain calm under pressure when greeting attendees and potentially selling tickets.

Info Tent Attendant

You'll be helping at the Info Tent! Volunteers need to be friendly, approachable and willing to have a good old chat, providing directions, answering questions and selling raffle tickets.

Merchandise Assistant

You'll be Selling our Million Paws Walk and RSPCA merchandise! Volunteers need to be friendly, approachable and comfortable handling money via both cash and EFTPOS.

500 Club Attendants

VIP treatment extraordinaire! Volunteers need to have excellent communication skills, be confident in approaching people and possess a friendly and polite attitude. Our VIPs are mostly our fabulous fundraisers that have raised \$500+ during their Million Paws Walk campaign.

Magnet Photos Attendants

We'll be hosting a photography installation where attendees can get a photo with their pup and have it printed straight onto Million Paws Walk-branded magnets to take home! You will need to be outgoing to pull attendees in, accepting money and giving the entrants any props.

Raffle Ticket Extraordinaires

We have an awesome raffle and you will be walking around the event site with POS machines and cash to sell raffle tickets. Volunteers need to be friendly, approachable, outgoing and willing to have a chat!

Suppawt Squad

The Suppawt Squad helps across the entire event! Volunteers need to be bubbly, enthusiastic, and confident in approaching people and dogs. You'll be general support and may be asked to help with several different jobs, including greeting attendees, ensuring water bowls around the event are constantly filled for the pooches, keeping eyes out for dog fights and general support.

Walk & Water Marshals

You'll be spread out across the 2km and 4km walks providing directional support for the thousands walking by, as well as ensuring water bowls along the route are always filled.
